

Sponsorship Opportunities: Education Center and Gardens



Graeser Family Education Center

Education Plaza

\$500,000

The plaza around the Education Pavilion and Gardens will allow for easy access to the individual gardens, fountains and buildings. The plaza will be designed for accessibility for all guests regardless of age, size, ability or limitations.

Covered Patio/Terrace

\$250,000

The Education Pavilion will be designed with an outer, covered deck that will have a view of the Education Gardens as well as the Woodland Garden. The covered outdoor walkways will allow visitors to experience the view from the building in all types of weather, and provide easy access from interior to exterior space.

Pathway to Beargrass Creek

\$100,000

The Education Pavilion and Garden sits up on a hill above Beargrass Creek. The pathway to the creek will wander through the Woodland Garden to take students to the creekside to study the flora and fauna. This will be a shaded walk through mature trees, and an important connector.

Single Edible Garden Bed

Small \$25,000 Large \$50,000

The Edible Garden located just outside the Education Center will be made up of small and large planted beds with herbs and other edibles. Volunteers and students will be able to work in these gardens to learn more about maintained edible gardens.



Education 100

\$10,000

The Education 100 is a group of 100 donors who have committed \$10,000 each to support the completion of the Education Pavilion. These 100 donors will be permanently recognized in the building through an artistic installation.

Benches around Plaza

\$10,000

Throughout the Education plaza, there will be benches available for visitors to sit and take in the beautiful surroundings. Available in both shade and sun, the benches will be a permanent part of the plaza landscape.

Benches along Pathway to Creek

\$5,000

Along the wooded walk to the creek through the Woodland Garden, the benches offer an opportunity for visitors to take a rest from their walk, or simply enjoy the mature canopy and sounds of birds singing in the trees.

Trees

\$1,500

In the Education Gardens surrounding the Education Pavilion and in the Woodland Gardens, a variety of trees will provide shade and beauty for visitors. The trees will be identified so that students can learn about the trees they are experiencing, and the importance of these trees in the landscape and surrounding environment.
