



Waterfront Botanical Gardens will hold a public meeting on January 22, 2019 from 4:00 pm - 5:00 pm at the Butchertown Social (<http://www.butchertownsocial.com/>) as part of the application for an Environmental Protection Agency Cleanup grant. The reference number for this grant opportunity is EPA-OLEM-OBLR-18-07. Waterfront Botanical Gardens is a brownfield site located at 1435 Frankfort Avenue, Louisville, KY 40206. Our nonprofit is building Louisville's first state-of-the-art botanical gardens on a revitalized landfill. The purpose of the public hearing is to give the community an opportunity to learn more about this project, ask questions, learn how grant dollars are being used to bring this project to life, and to make comments about the grant application and the Analysis of Brownfield Cleanup Alternatives (ABCA) document.

A copy of the grant draft proposal and a draft of the ABCA will be available for viewing. The public will have an opportunity to verbally comment on the drafts. Comments will be captured in meeting minutes by Waterfront Botanical Gardens staff.
